

# CERAMIC COATING MAINTENANCE



## PROTECT YOUR **INVESTMENT** WITH A LASTING SHINE

### MID-WEEK MAINTENANCE (OPTIONAL)

- STEP 1** - Wipe down with **Eco Shine** waterless wash using the one pass / flip towel method.
- STEP 2** - Follow with **Ignition** detail spray to promote self-cleaning properties of the coating.

### WEEKLY WASH MAINTENANCE

- STEP 1** - Using **Shiff** soap, wash vehicle utilizing the proper washing method.
- STEP 2** - Dry Vehicle.
- STEP 3** - Wipe down with **Throttle** detail spray.

### MONTHLY MAINTENANCE

- STEP 1** - Using **Shiff** soap, wash vehicle utilizing the proper washing method.
- STEP 2** - Dry Vehicle.
- STEP 3** - Apply **Punch-It** sunergy spray.

### ANNUAL MAINTENANCE

- STEP 1** - Using **Shiff** soap, wash vehicle utilizing the proper washing method.
- STEP 2** - Rinse vehicle and apply **Smooth Move** paint decontaminator while the vehicle is wet.
- STEP 3** - Re-wash vehicle with **Shiff** soap utilizing the proper washing method.
- STEP 4** - Dry Vehicle.
- STEP 5** - Use **Slick Back** primer polish to remove light defects.
- STEP 6** - Apply **Cherry** silica wax to entire vehicle.
- STEP 7** - Remove the layer of **Cherry** silica wax using **Clutch** silica spray applied to a soft microfiber applicator pad.
- STEP 8** - Remove **Clutch** using (2) plush microfiber towels.

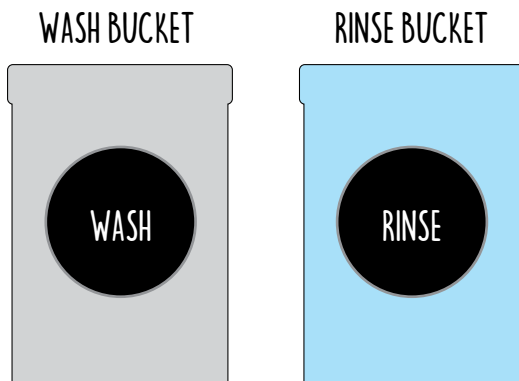
# PROPER WASHING METHODS

## PRODUCTS USED

- (2) Buckets
- (2) Grit Guards
- (4) Flat Out wash pads
- (1) Block Party wash block
- Soap of your choice

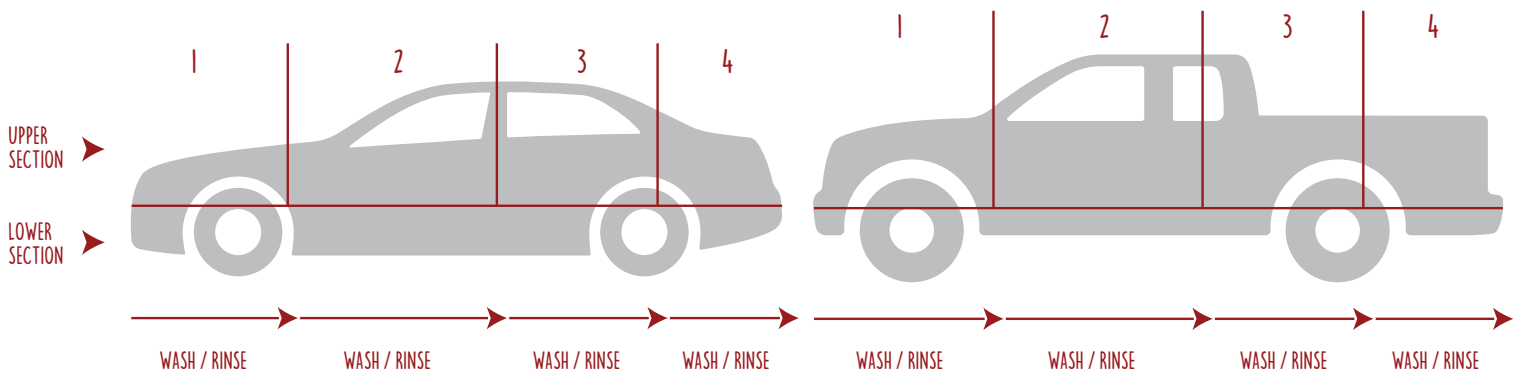
## 2 BUCKET METHOD

Always use (2) buckets when washing with Grit Guards placed under each bucket. Fill one bucket with soap ("WASH") and one bucket with pure water ("RINSE")



## EXAMPLE OF WASHING UPPER SECTIONS (SEE DIAGRAM BELOW)

- STEP 1** - Use Flat Out wash pads, one pad for each section.
- STEP 2** - As you move through sections 1-4 on the vehicle, drop used pad in "RINSE" bucket. Grab a new pad and proceed. Follow this same process as you move around the vehicle.
- STEP 3** - Once you've completed all 4 sections on one side of the vehicle, rinse out pads from your "RINSE" bucket and place in "WASH" bucket. Proceed with the same steps on the other side of the vehicle.



## EXAMPLE OF WASHING LOWER SECTION

- STEP 1** - Use Block Party wash block for bottom six inches of the vehicle. (Block Party measures 6" for ease of use.)
